

NOTICE FOR PARENTS – Section 504 Plans

Students with disabilities who do not qualify for an Individual Education Program (IEP), as required by the Federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and implementing provisions of the School Code, may qualify for services under Section 504 of the Federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973 if the child has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more life activities; has a record of physical or mental impairment; or is regarded as having a physical or mental impairment.

If your child has a permanent or temporary health concern or mild disability for which he/she requires accommodations, please call the PPS office to arrange a time for a 504 Meeting to develop a plan. 708-758-1410

Students who are found not eligible to receive special education or related services may be eligible to receive accommodations under a 504 Plan.
